The major activity for the Company during the quarter was preparing for the operation of the Mantuan Downs bentonite mine in expectation of mining lease approval by the Queensland Minister for Mines and Energy. Plan of operations has been settled, and product extraction and logistics contractors are being finalised. Interest from international industrial minerals companies remains high.

Rock sample testing of the nepheline syenite and rare earths tenements are being undertaken, and in an expansion of its portfolio of industrial minerals, PEV signed a conditional agreement to acquire a natural sodium bicarbonate tenement in Southern Queensland.

PEV applied for, and received approval by the Queensland Govt. under its Waterwise program, for its calcium bentonite to be a specified product attracting rebates for residential purchasers.
