




2016-17 HIGH VOLUME AIR SAMPLER DUST MONITORING

DEPOSITIONAL DUST MONITORING.




Insoluble Matter is Ash + Combustible Matter

Ash is more representative of dust component, remainder is typically organic matter (e.g. insects)

Annual average below limit of 4g/m2/month at all sites



DUST ISOPLETH FOR THE ANNUAL AVERAGE INCLUDING APRIL 2017






Surface water monitoring locations extract






SURFACE WATER SALINITY – HUNTER RIVER



 Electrical Conductivity – note reducing difference between Hunter River monitoring sites upstream and downstream of the Mine.




SURFACE WATER SALINITY – DART BROOK



 Electrical Conductivity – Upstream EC fluctuates with flow rates (influenced by rainfall) and downstream EC may be influenced by Hunter River flows.





canoes, the construction of semporary shelters and traditional hunting techniques (i.e., the cutting of toe holds). Trees were also sometimes carved or decorated. Bark was removed from tree trunks using stone or steel axes, exposing the sapwood, and leaving scars of various sizes.

This Scarred Tree was salvaged under approval by the NSW State Government and is protected under the provisions of the National Parks and Wildlife act 1974
