



Proposed Work Program

- Proposed 5 15 chip/core holes
- Detailed lithology and structure logging
- Sampling of coal seams for coal quality analysis
- Geophysical wireline logging of all holes
- Upgrade of JORC status to 50% indicated & measured
- Planning 2nd round drilling to bring northern and eastern areas to indicated & measured

TARGET: Rangal Coal Measures (3 Seams) **STATUS**: **107Mt** JORC inferred, MDL in application phase







TARGET: Rangal Coal Measures **STATUS**: Detailed modelling for drill targeting







East Wandoan Project

Project Highlights

- 40 to 200 MT exploration target
- Maiden JORC resource by December 2011
- Adjacent to Cockatoo Coal *"Bottle Tree" (35.2Mt)* and Stanmore
 Coal *"The Range" (229Mt)* projects
- · Drilling confirms shallow open cut potential

The East Wandoan project consists of EPCs 1955, 2237 and EPCAs 1987, 2481 and covering an area of 1093km². These exploration permits are searching for Juandah Coal Measure of the Lower Walloon sub group.


Blackwood has identified 5 target areas as shown in the adjacent map.

Priority Area A is the focus of exploration in 2011. High lights include:

- · 14 open holes completed
- 7.5 m to 11.6 m of net coal over ~ 3km strike
- Depth of coal 14 80 m

The Wandoan to Banana *"missing link"* proposed route passes through the northern section of EPC 1955. Scheduled construction completion end of 2014. Export links to WICET Stage 2 development.




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Enterprise Value (EV) of Listed Coal Sector Explorers and Developers – November 2011






