REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION

Australian Pacific Coal Limited (ASX: AQC) (the 'Company' or 'AQC') requests a voluntary suspension of the Company's securities with effect from the commencement of trading on Tuesday 30 August 2022.
