Non-renounceable rights issue – share issue and s708A cleansing notice

Australian Pacific Coal Limited (the **Company**) advises that in accordance with its announcement on 22 October 2015, it has now issued a further 57,428,750 fully paid Ordinary Shares (**Rights Issue Shares**) under a 1:1 Non-Renounceable Rights Issue to shareholders at \$0.004 cents per share raising gross proceeds of \$229,715. This issue was in respect of both applications for additional shares by eligible shareholders and applications for shortfall shares by eligible investors.

Attached is an Appendix 3B with respect to the issue of the Rights Issue Shares.

The Company provides notice to the ASX for the purpose of section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) that it has issued the Rights Issue Shares without disclosure to investors under Part 6D.2 of the Corporations Act.

The Company states that as at the date of this notice:

- it has complied with the provisions of Chapter 2M of the Corporations Act as they apply to the Company and section 674 of the Corporations Act; and
- it is not aware of any excluded information within the meaning of sections 708A(7) and 708A(8) of the Corporations Act.
